

2023-2024 Tri-Town Basketball Rules

3rd & 4th Grade Rules:

- *Person to Person* Defense Only. No zones or *full court* defense is allowed. Defenders must stay within 2-3 steps of their opponent (steals are allowed). 1st offense: warning; 2nd offense and any offense after: technical foul issued.
 - *Double teaming* is allowed in the bucket/lane area ONLY.
 - 28.5 Ball will be used.
 - Nine (9') foot baskets will be used.
 - Six (6) minute *quarters*, *stop-time* and five (5) minute *halftime*.
 - Two (2) minute *overtime period*, if necessary. If tied after OT, game will be scored as a tie.
 - 5 seconds in the bucket/lane area.
 - *Foul Shots* - Player must start behind *foul line*, but may cross over during shot. No penalty.
 - All other IAABO Rules will apply.

5th & 6th Grade Rules:

- 28.5 Ball will be used.
 - Ten (10') foot baskets will be used.
 - Seven (7) minute *quarters*, *stop-time* and ten (10) minute *half time*.
 - Three (3) minute *overtime period*, if necessary. If tied after OT, game will be scored as a tie.
 - Any *Defense* allowed except that there will be NO full-court press in the 1st half or with more than a ten (10) point lead.

General Basketball Rules:

- NO MORE 1-1 FREE THROWS. Two (2) foul shots after 5 team fouls in a quarter. Team fouls reset each quarter. Scoreboard will show a max of 5 fouls per quarter
- *Timeouts* - 2 full-timeouts per half. Timeouts DO NOT carry over. One timeout will be added to the second half timeouts for OT.
- *Technical fouls* will result in 2 free throws and ball possession.
- Our goal is to provide *Equal* opportunities for all participants. Therefore, please use equal playing time for all players.
